Photographer Sam Howard’s “Rocky Mountain Autumn” is exhibited in the Depot Art Center’s anniversary show, “The American West,” which runs through May 23 at the gallery in the 1881 Santa Fe depot, which was converted to an art gallery by members of the Littleton Fine Arts Guild as a 1976 Bicentennial project.
