Juror Selection Guidelines

Most of our shows are juried. Juror names will come from a variety of sources, including but not limited to:

- Artists and photographers you might know
- Teachers you know or from whom you've taken classes
- Local colleges
- Recommendations from LFAG members
- Other artist member organizations like the Denver Art Student League, Heritage Fine Arts Guild and others.

After a candidate has been identified, and before you contact them, check out their website, their biography, their credentials and anything else you can find about their qualifications.

The Candidate should be experienced and open to evaluating all 2D and 3D disciplines.

Candidates for consideration for All Colorado and Colorado Aperture should be reviewed first with the President. The President will follow up with the Board. Qualifications are held at a higher standard than our member-only juried shows.

LFAG pays a stipend to the juror and the amounts vary depending on the show. Currently all shows, with the exception of three pay a stipend of \$100.00.

The three exceptions pay the current stipend below:

1. Plein Air Festival – at this time, the Show Chairperson selects the juror and the stipend is negotiated between the Chairperson and the juror. The Board must approve this stipend.
2. All Colorado - \$400.00
3. Colorado Aperture - \$300.00

The juror Acknowledgment and Guidelines for Juror form is filed in the Job Guidelines blue 3-ring binder at the gallery. Each juror must sign the Acknowledgment form. The form is shared with the Show Chairpersons as well as, the President, Secretary and the Show Chair Coordinator. A permanent copy resides at the gallery. Currently we do not have a central place to file electronic copies. Please note that the forms for the two shows whose artwork is selected via Café are slightly different from the regular shows because of the way they are juried.
